Sight For Life Foundation was established in 2001 by Dr. Eva Liang, a Board certified Ophthalmologist, along with Juliet Vestal, a lifelong friend.

The Foundation's goal is to assist people with treatable vision loss, who would otherwise be unable to afford proper eye care.

The need for the Foundation was obvious when Dr. Liang encountered many patients with sight threatening diseases who were unable to follow through with their eye care needs due to a lack of insurance or private funding. Even though some doctors are willing to donate their time, the patients still need medications, medical supplies, or further treatments that cannot always be completed in the doctor's office. Sight for Life was established to fill this gap in our community.

Patients who are accepted for treatment by the Foundation receive eye care free of charge. Those who wish to apply for services may do so directly or through a referral from their participating ophthalmologist or optometrist.

The Gift of Sight

Through charitable donations and participating doctors Sight For Life has:

- Performed Ophthalmic procedures or services valued at nearly \$500,000 which include:
 - Retinal detachment repairs
 - Corneal transplants
 - Cataract extractions with intraocular lens implants
 - Secondary lens implants
 - Glaucoma filtering procedures
 - Diabetic retinal laser treatments
 - Ophthalmic tumor resections
- Received donated services and favorable contracts resulting in a savings of over \$350,000

What if you could no longer see well enough to drive or read, even with glasses or contacts? Given the choice, would you rather live 10 years without sight or opt to die sooner if your vision could not be improved? Researchers from Wills Eye Hospital in Philadelphia asked 325 of their patients this question. Most patients, regardless of age, say they would be willing to giving up time for better vision.

Our Mission

By providing charitable eye care services, we strive to improve the sight of Nevadans with treatable vision loss. Our goal is to improve lives through better sight for those who would otherwise have no hope. The Sight for Life team of doctors, support staff and Foundation supporters are committed to making a difference in how Nevadans see.

Administrative costs are minimal as there is no paid staff. Office space and support staff is donated by Dr. Rudy Manthei of Nevada Eye & Ear. In addition, the Foundation is supported by donations and proceeds from an annual fund-raiser.
